Itinerary Information Start points are now fixed although there may be changes to lunch and eleveneses venues. Such changes will always be notified. All rides October to March (inclusive) start at 9.30 am unless indicated.

The following have proved useful: 1. Ride together 2. single out if "car up/down" called. 3. Point out potholes or other hazards to following riders. 4. Negotiate awkward manoeuvres as a single group, don't "nip across". 5. Wait for slower riders to catch up at the next road junction. 6. Tell leader if you go your own way. 7. Try not to ride forward of the leader in unfamiliar territory. 8. All riders to be CTC/Cycling UK members. 9. All bikes to have effective rear mudflaps. 10. Don't wave vehicles on - and be wary of drivers waving us across. We must each make an independent assessment of each situation before crossing.

Ice/Strong Wind/Heavy Rain: In the event of dangerous or exceptionally difficult conditions, it is the leader's decision to cancel, delay or shorten the ride. If the decision is made early it can be transmitted to all those likely to be involved. Please email cladders@icloud.com before 7.45am. (Those who prefer to make a decision later should meet at Gregg's in Rugby by 10am where a ride-possibility can be discussed.)
